Should you return to practice, please let us know and we would be happy to assist you with changing your membership category (note: Regular and Sustained members **MUST** participate in the Maintenance of Certification program and pay the appropriate annual dues).

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## **Retired PA member category:**

Retired PA member is hereby defined as a Physician Assistant who no longer wishes to maintain their Canadian Certified Physician Assistant designation who has wholly or substantially ceased to be engaged in paid employment or self-employment. The term of membership of a Retired PA Member will be annual, subject to:

- payment of all dues and fees
- renewal in accordance with the membership and governance policies of the Association as adopted and recorded by resolution of the board.

Subject to the Act, a Retired Member shall be entitled to the privilege of the floor, to receive notice of and attend all meetings of members, will be entitled to all benefits and privileges of membership, and each such member shall be entitled to one (1) vote at such meetings. Retired members shall not be entitled to hold office.

Benefits:

- Retired Pas are entitled to use the CCPA-Retired designation,
- Are entitled to all benefits of membership
- Are entitled to vote at the annual members' meeting
- are not required to participate in the Maintenance of Certification program

## Please note:

Although retired CCPAs are not required to participate in the MOC Program, you will continue to have access to MAINPORT and given a retirement MOC cycle. If you return to practice and your CAPA membership status is changed back to active (Regular or Sustained) within one year, your MOC cycle will continue from its original start date. If you return to practice later than one year, you will be given a new active MOC Cycle, which will start on the date you return as an active CAPA member.
